After almost 20 years of waiting for a building permit to build a church building, and after seven years of moving from place to place without a space of our own, we have a unique opportunity to buy a building that's almost move-in ready.

We need about \$50,000 to help us buy this property, pay all the taxes and fees, and do some minor renovations that will allow us to move in. Please pray for God's will and provision for the acquisition of this space. We would like to move in by June of this year.
